

AFRICAN NATIONAL CONGRESS**ESTABLISHMENT OF SUBCOUNCILS****MOTIVATION ON THE PROPOSAL SUBMITTED FOR APPROVAL BY THE DERMACATION BOARD**

As the African National Congress we wish to put the following to your attention, which will serve as our motivation as to why we have proposed such boundaries and the way s/councils should be demarcated.

- I. Generally Khayelitsha is a vast area with one ward for an example having $\pm 17\ 000$ registered voters excluding general residents which therefore means that we need to at least cluster 4 wards to form up a s/council.
- II. We don't support the issue of mixing areas especially that have completely different service delivery needs for an example the issue of areas in Khayelitsha added to Somerset, Maccassar and Strand area as it crosses the Badden Powell drive with a vast distance between these areas
- III. Wards must be clustered along reasonable boundaries which will be easier to work and allow sensible fair way for the municipality
- IV. We note that S/Council 21 has more than seven wards because the area is easier to work around and mainly has a sense of overlapping of the wards there and the area is not vast. If it cannot be approved as is we are flexible to then subdivide the area and further redemarcate it to become 2 subcouncils which will be as follows:- Wards 16, 108 and 114 with the other subcouncil formed by Wards 11, 14, 17 and 19. This will then take us to 25 s/councils which should have been the case any way because we have added five new wards from the previous term, which is from 111 to 116 wards
